Sustainable TF: for SMEs, for Agriculture, for women



with Southeast and East Asia leading developing countries






#### **Implementation of TF: Progress 2019-2021**

(128 countries covered in both 2019/2021 Surveys)





Despite supply chain disruptions during COVID-19, implementation increased by over 5 percentage points since 2019.




## Implementation of Sustainable and Resilient TF measures








Accelerate implementation of digital trade facilitation measures


