To Customs and Participating Government Agencies

- Clearance can be conducted prior to arrival
- Real-time online payment implemented
- Risk Management targeting less than 40% of consignments
- Scanned documents assisting with clearance and audits
- Increased in efficient clearance process
- Increased in revenue collection

- Access to Payment facility for deferred payments
- Online availability of data and procedures
- Improved conformity with regulatory requirements
- Online processing (little to no physical contact)



OBSERVED BENEFITS



Environmental Impact with the automation

- Reduced cost in paper (95% 100% reduction)
- Reduced trips to participating Government offices (86% 100% reductions)
- Power Consumption at the Government Data Centre unaffected



ASYREC PROJECT (2022)



- Automated System for Release Emergency Consignments
- Vanuatu is one of the most 'at-risk' countries to natural hazards (cyclones, flooding, droughts, rising sea levels, seismic and volcanic activities)
- ASYREC is a tool of utmost importance for the humanitarian aid coordination mechanism, the Global Logistics Cluster
- To provide coordinated, efficient and facilitated imports for humanitarian relief and medical supplies during emergency crises, including the COVID-19 pandemic
- To save lives and to ensure relevant and sufficient aid reaches those in need
