


OUR PURPOSE









- ❖ After negotiations with the Ministry of Food Production, a total of seven (7) hand tractors was given to the Agricultural Society of Trinidad and Tobago.
- ❖ These hand tractors was distributed to farmers groups throughout the regions of Trinidad and is being managed by the Agricultural Society of Trinidad and Tobago to ensure that farmers in those areas are benefitting from the tractors.

STRATEGIC INTERVENTION: ACCESS TO FINANCING

- The Agricultural Development Bank in partnership with the Agricultural Society of Trinidad and Tobago implemented the Reaping Opportunities Loan (ROL) in order to assist farmers who are less fortunate.

- The ceiling of this loan is fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00)

- With the implementation of the pump at Plum Mitan, over three hundred farmers are benefitting.
- Farmers are stating that they are now receiving a vast amount of income with the implementation of the pump at Plum Mitan.
- Types of crops that farmers are planting in that area are cucumbers, watermelons, pimentos, tomatoes, hot peppers, bodi and ochros.

CLEARING AND DESILTING OF IRRIGATION CHANNELS IN FELICITY, TRINIDAD

- ❖ The Agricultural Society of Trinidad and Tobago cleaned and desilted clogged irrigation channels at the Felicity Food Crop Project.
- ❖ This benefitted approximately 300 farmers cultivating 500 acres of lands.
