









- Trade Facilitation is ever more important for developing countries.
- Yet, Trade Facilitation is also more difficult to implement for them then for developed economies






The quarterly Transport and Trade Facilitation Newsletter provides information on latest events and publications + it features selected topical articles.










UNCTAD has continued and expanded its on-line databases aimed at supporting evidence-based research, technical cooperation and capacity-building in the area of transport and trade facilitation

UNCTAD's country-level Liner Shipping Connectivity Index (LSCI) 2016 has just been published in its 13th year.

The Index provides an indicator of a country's access to the global liner shipping network and thus to overseas markets for most manufactured goods.



UNCTAD assists numerous member countries in preparing for implementation of the WTO TFA.




















UNCTAD's Empowerment Programme for NTFCs

UNCTAD, the German aid agency GIZ and Trade Mark East Africa collaborate to provide assistance for the Agreement on Trade Facilitation in the **East African Community** (EAC)





UNCTAD continued the ASYCUDA implementation, its largest technical assistance programme (presently 98 countries & territories, 113 since its inception).


- One new country: Kazakhstan
- In total, there were 60 operational ASYCUDA technical assistance projects.
- In 2015, UNCTAD staff and consultants undertook 300 support, training and advisory missions, including 225 training sessions, for an audience of more than 2000 participants.

Several new MOUs and partnerships were initiated or signed, however funding or allocation of human resources is required to carry forward the initiatives.




Research: Trade Logistics & Sustainable Development



Trade facilitation reforms are key for the future development of nations.


