

#### AGREEMENT ON TRADE FACILITATION

#### Preamble

Member

Having regard to the negotiations launched under the Doha Ministerial Declaration;

Recalling and reaffirming the mandate and principles contained in paragraph 27 of the Doha Ministerial Declaration (WT/MIN(01)/DEC/1) and in Annex D of the Decision of the Doha Work Programme adopted by the General Council on 1 August 2004 (WT/L/579), as well as in paragraph 33 of and Annex E to the Hong Kong Ministerial Declaration (WT/MIN(05)/DEC);

Desiring to clarify and improve relevant aspects of Articles V, VIII and X of the GATT 1994 with a view to further expediting the movement, release and clearance of goods, including goods in transiti:

Recognizing the particular needs of developing and especially least-developed country Members and desiring to enhance assistance and support for capacity building in this area;

Recognizing the need for effective cooperation among Members on trade facilitation and customs compliance issues;

Hereby agree as follows:

#### SECTION 1

#### ARTICLE 1: PUBLICATION AND AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION

#### 1 Publication

- 1.1 Each Member shall promptly publish the following information in a non-discriminatory and easily accessible manner in order to enable governments, traders, and other interested parties to become acquainted with them:
  - procedures for importation, exportation, and transit (including port, airport, and other entry-point procedures), and required forms and documents;
  - applied rates of duties and taxes of any kind imposed on or in connection with importation or exportation;
  - fees and charges imposed by or for governmental agencies on or in connection with importation, exportation or transit;
  - (d) rules for the classification or valuation of products for customs purposes;
  - laws, regulations, and administrative rulings of general application relating to rules of origin;



#### How to present the instrument of ratification?

The Trade Facilitation Agreement will enter into force once two-thirds of Members have de their acceptance of this Protocol. This Protocol of Amendment, which was officially opene Trade Facilitation into the WTO Agreement.

This page responds to frequently asked questions about acceptance procedures and prov follow in preparing their instruments of acceptance:

#### What is the WTO practice regarding the deposit of acceptances?

The WTO closely follows established United Nations depositary practice, which is based in concerning valid acceptance set out below.

#### What must be stated in an instrument of acceptance?






#### Share of Categories A, B, C by region

Based on % of all notifiable article items - Global




#### The 5 most notified measures in Category A

## **ARTICLE 23.2**

Each Member shall establish and/or maintain a national committee on trade facilitation or designate an existing mechanism to facilitate both domestic coordination and implementation of the provisions of this Agreement.
