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


#### Funding source: Trust fund resources

#### Origins of UNCTAD trust fund resources, 2012-2016 (in thousands of US dollars)




#### Funding source: Developed country contributions

#### Funding source: Developing country funding


Self-financing vs. financing South-South Cooperation (share of total developing country funding, 2016)




- Funds to support South-South cooperaiton
- Funds to support self-financed projects




### Funding source: Share of total trust fund resources, by origin

### Funding source: UN regular programme & Development Account

#### UN regular programme of TC

- Expenditures of \$0.7 million in 2016 (-43%)
- ✓ To finance advisory services and training: such as training on key international economic issues (para 166 of the UNCTAD X Plan of Action)

#### Development Account

- √ 23 projects implemented with a total expenditure of \$2.6 million in 2016 (-7%)
- ✓ New 11th tranche (2018-2021): Expected to access \$4.9 million to finance 8 projects


### Funding source: Financing of Junior Professional Officers (JPOs)

- UNCTAD JPO programme is part of the UN JPO programme;
- UN DESA/CDO recruits and administers JPOs for the UN Secretariat and its entities;
- Contributions from donors for UNCTAD JPO programme are exclusive from the overall TC funding to UNCTAD trust funds;
- In 2016, Germany remained the sole contributor to UNCTAD JPO programme;
- UNCTAD calls on more donors to support its JPO programme

2015 2016 Interregional Interregional projects projects Country Country 28% projects projects 39% 53% 56% Regional projects 16% Regional projects


#### TC expenditures: Distribution by product

- 29 products under four themes
- Uneven allocation of TC resources among products
- The top three products in 2016:

Product	Expenditures in 2016 (in thousands of dollars)	Share of total Toolbox product expenditures
ASYCUDA	18'614	56.9%
DMFAS	4'473	13.7%
eRegulations and eRegistrations systems	2'531	7.7%



### TC functioning: Database of formal requests for UNCTAD technical cooperation

- Actions to improve the request database since 73rd session of WP in Sept. 2016:
- Cross-checking request information to ensure data accuracy and completeness;
- Updating with new requests received by UNCTAD
- Creating a dashboard to provide an illustrative overview of the request data
- New request database: http://unctad.org/projects/tc/en/Pages/Requests.aspx

#### TC functioning: Strengthening RBM

Issuing RBM Guidelines for project planning

Piloting 10 minimum RBM Requirements (July 2016- June 2017)

RBM training for project managers and senior management

Project Planning:

Prodoc complies with minimum RBM requirements

Project monitoring:

- Quarterly report on implementation status;
- Data on IAs reported every two quarters

#### TC functioning: Gender mainstreaming

Piloting the gender checklist in new TC projects (April 2016 - June 2017)

Project clearance by divisional gender focal points from gender perspective

Training on Gender mainstreaming in UNCTAD's technical cooperation projects and flagship reports in Feb. 2017

#### TC functioning: New funding mechanism

- Concept note on a funding mechanism for pending technical cooperation requests received by UNCTAD was circulated to member States for consultation;
- Informal consultations with regional groups held;
- A revised version of the proposal to be issued.

### TC functioning: Contribution to UN system-wide coherence

United Nations Inter-Agency Cluster on Trade and Productive Capacity: enhancing its role in the United Nations system-wide coherence.

#### ☐ Highlights in 2016:

- √ Taking steps to establish a Multi-Donor Trust Fund to scale up activities of the Cluster - Information session organized during UNCTAD XIV in Nairobi.
- ✓ Participated in the formulation of UNDAFs mainly in Europe and Central Asia with UNDAF cycles starting in 2016 or 2017.
- ✓ Sharing UNCTAD experience in the implementation of Delivering Results Together Fund initiatives (e.g. Tanzania)

### Way forward: 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

#### ■ Main actions in 2017

- To update UNCTAD Toolbox;
- To further enhance the management of request data and improve request database;
- ✓ Drawing lessons from the pilot phase to better mainstream RBM requirements and gender dimensions in TC projects;
- ✓ To share with member States revised document on new funding mechanism to better match the supply of funds to the demand for UNCTAD TC;
- ✓ To work towards the establishment of UN Inter-Agency Cluster Multi-Donor Trust Fund on Trade and Productive Capacity;
- ✓ To further improve TC website
