A Roadmap



- Definition of a "common" product classification to collect information more comprehensively:
 - Establishment of a pluri-institutional working group ?
 - Interaction with the World Customs Organization ?
- How could competent authorities define a regulation framework conducive (at the national and regional levels) of sustained and sustainable hemp sectoral development?
 - Based on robust scientific evidence
 - Primary objective/scope: consistency of legal rules with a whole-plant approach?
- In depth analysis of existing production/value chains to identify best (and possibly reproducible) practices may be desirable:
 - How to compare experiences across countries (and time)?
 - How to identify the role played by the regulatory framework and its evolution over time?
 - How to access relevant data?
 - Dissemination and practical implications?
 - Establishment and governance of a pluri-institutional working group ?



- Establishment of a multi-stakeholders working group to define and promote best practices?
 - Support to governments willing to promote hemp sectoral development
 - Support the integration of hemp cultivation and transformation into sustainable development strategies
 - Enhances exchange of best practices and repository of sectorial analysis on a sound socio-economic-environmental basis
 - How can trade of (processed) hemp products from developing countries be promoted? e.g. Geographical Indications and Appellation of Origin
 - "Universality" of hemp varieties available
 - Would there be an ideal institutional mechanism to make this happen?
