A HIGHLIGHT

CUSTOMS UNION

2005

Enabling the EAC Partner States to enjoy economies of scale, with a view to supporting the process of economic development through the establishment of a Single Customs Territory.

COMMON MARKET

2010

Accelerating economic growth and development while maintaining a liberal stance towards the **5** Freedoms of movement for all factors of production in the region.

MONETARY UNION

2013

Laying the groundwork within a 10-year span, while allowing the EAC Partner States to progressively converge their currencies into a single currency in the Community.

POLITICAL FEDERATION

ONGOING

Putting in place initiatives to fast-track political integration. In May 2017 EAC Heads of State adopted the **Political Confederation** as a transitional model of the East African Political Federation.




1st positive cases of covid-19 in EAC PANIC IN REGION

- Kenya confirmed a Coronavirus (COVID-19) case on the 12th March 2020, as the first case reported in Kenya.
- ✤ Rwanda reported its 1st case on 14th March 2020.
- Tanzania received the first case on 16 March 2020.
- Burundi confirmed first case of corona virus on 25 March 2020.
- South Sudan reported the country's first case of COVID-19 on April 5th 2020.
- ✤ Uganda reports 1st Corona Virus. 09-Jun-2020.



Sixty km queues as COVID turns Kenyan border crossing into lorry park

Before COVID-19, Kenyan driver Joseph Kimani used five-hour wait to cross from Kenya into Uganda with his cargo of diesel.

With Covid 19 the queue on the Kenyan side, extended upto 60 km (37 miles), take five days to clear and, for them, life on the road had become literally that.

"The long queues were attributed to Covid 19 related health checks.



EAST AFRICAN COMMUNITY (EAC) ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES TO FACILITATE MOVEMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- 2. OBJECTIVES OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES
 - 2.1. To complement national measures against the COVID-19 pandemic;
 - 2.2. To ensure smooth and uninterrupted movement of goods and services during the COVID-19 pandemic;
 - To encourage local production of essential products during this COVID-19 pandemic;
 - 2.4. To enhance regional awareness on measures instituted against the COVID-19 pandemic; and
 - To mitigate the negative impact of COVID-19 on the movement of goods and services.

3.1. TRADE FACILITATION

Partner States must continue to facilitate the movement of goods and services from and to other Partner States by:

- 3.1.1. Adopting a multi-Sectoral and coordinated approach;
- 3.1.2. Providing access at all designated points for entry and exit of goods;
- 3.1.3. Providing for adequate personnel at designated points;
- Treating cross border movement of trucks and cargo as essential services;
- 3.1.5. Directing Transporters and Transporters Associations to adhere to the requirement of having only two (2) to three (3) operators of the truck including the driver;
- 3.1.6. Enforcing mandatory screening or testing of truck drivers and crew at border posts and undertake monitoring during transit at selected inland points;
- 3.1.7. Quarantining those with symptoms for 14 days under the
