THE COUNCIL OF GOVERNORS

- 1. The Council of Governors (CoG) is a public body established under Section 19 of the Intergovernmental Relations Act (IGRA). It is composed of the Governors of the forty-seven (47) Counties of the Republic of Kenya.
- 2. The functions of COG include, to provide a forum for:
- (a) consultation amongst County Governments;
- (b) sharing of information on the performance of the counties in the execution of their functions with the objective of learning and promotion of best practice and where necessary, initiating preventive or corrective action;
- (c) considering matters of common interest to County Governments.
- 3. Subject to Section 20 (3) of the IGRA, CoG has established sectoral committees for the better carrying out of its functions.

THE TRADE/INDUSTRIALIZATION FUNCTION AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS:

- OPEN AIR MARKETS (PRODUCE AND LIVESTOCK)
- MARKET DAYS/ REVENUE FOCUS
- PRODUCE MARKETS-BASIC STALLS
- SINGLE BUSINESS PERMIT TO ADDRESS MULTIPLICITY OF LEVIES
- MINIMAL ROLE FOR LOCAL (AUTHORITIES) GOVERNMENTS,
 EXCEPT ON MATTERS OF LAND AND LAND USE PLANNING





COOPERATIVES:

- 1908-FIRST COOPERATIVE
- 1931-FIRST COOPERATIVES ORDINANCE,
- 1946- 'NATIVES' ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN COOPERATIVES)
- COTTON GINNERIES, KCC, KPCU, KGGCU
- STRUGGLE FOR 'CONTROL' OF COOPERATIVES AFTER DEVOLUTION





KENYA INDUSTRIAL ESTATES (1967):

- INDUSTRIAL SHEDS AND SME PARKS
- INCUBATION, FINANCING AND ADVISORY SERVICES

DISTRICT INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT OFFICES

- NEVER FOUND ITS PURPOSE IN THE FORMER OR CURRENT SYSTEM
- PRESIDENTIAL DRIVE TO PROMOTE THE 'JUA KALI' AGENDA IN THE 1990S
- INVESTMENT PROMOTION CENTRE ACT, CAP 485 (1986)-REPEALED
- RURAL ENTERPRISE FUND (1991/92)
- CONSTITUENCY BASED INDUSTRIAL PARKS, MARKETS, JUA KALI SHEDS

- COUNTY GOVERNMENTS INHERITED THE ROLES OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES;
- COUNTY GOVERNMENTS TOOK OVER THE PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT IN THE TRADE AND WEIGHTS/MEASURES DOCKETS;
- NO PROGRAMMES RELATING TO TRADE, ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIALIZATION TRANSFERRED TO COUNTIES
- LIMITED STRATEGIC ENGAGEMENT BETWEEN THE 2 LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT





- DOCUMENTATION OF OPPORTUNITIES IN COUNTY GOVERNMENTS;
- INVESTMENT CONFERENCES;
- COUNTY PROGRAMMES AND INITIATIVES TO PROMOTE TRADE,
 ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIALIZATION. FOR EXAMPLE
 - KITUI, LAIKIPIA, KAKAMEGA. KISUMU, KERICHO
- POLICIES AND LAWS RELATING TO LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT;
 - INCLUDING INVESTMENT CORPORATIONS OF THE COUNTY GOVERNMENTS
- COUNTY READINESS TO STIMULATE INDUSTRIAL GROWTH IS VERY HIGH.





WAY FORWARD

- RE-EXAMINE THE ROLE OF GOVERNMENT IN ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIALIZATION
 - DELINEATE ROLES BETWEEN THE 2 LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT
- ENHANCE INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AND INTRA-GOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS
- DISESTABLISH NON-STRATEGIC GOVERNMENT OWNED INSTITUTIONS
- PROMOTE COUNTY INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN FOREIGN MISSIONS
- GIVE LIFE TO THE POST 2010 OPERATION MODE
