1980 MONTEVIDEO TREATY

Institutes the Latin American Integration Association (LAIA), an intergovernmental organization based in Montevideo, Uruguay, to promote the integration process of the region.

The long-term objective of such process is the gradual and progressive establishment of a Latin-American Common Market.
