



1. Technical assistance activities 2020-2021

- Co-organizing webinars and workshops on consumer protection with ISO COPOLCO, EU Commission and ESCWA
- Implementing a UNDA project on strengthening social protection for pandemic responses (Africa, Asia and the Pacific and Western Asia)
- ✓ Launching a project on delivering online dispute resolution for consumers (ASEAN)
- ✓ Joining a regional technical project on the promotion of sustainable consumption (ASEAN)
- ✓ Participating in Iberoamerican Forum dialogues
- Delivering 2 classes on international consumer protection and on dispute resolution and redress (Latin America)
- Providing advisory services to member States such as Brazil, Chile, Dominican Republic, Peru and Uzbekistan

- ✓ Working Group on modalities of voluntary peer review exercises
