Mandate proposed to the IGE

>Renew the mandate of the working group on consumer product safety until the ninth United Nations Conference to Review All Aspects of the Set of Multilaterally Agreed Equitable Principles and Rules for the Control of Restrictive Business Practices, to continue work on strengthening consumer product safety frameworks at the regional and national levels and improving international cooperation to protect consumers from hazards to their health and safety, to propose a recommendation on general consumer product safety, to explore the viability and potentially the development of a Model Law for the implementation of the recommendation on preventing the cross-border distribution of known unsafe consumer products and to report on its continued work to the eighth session of the Intergovernmental Group of Experts on Consumer Protection Law and Policy
