

I. Objectives

The objectives of the study is to provide:

- The status quo on the consideration of compliance programs by authorities and courts in
 South and Central America in cases of legal infringements, and if so, to what extent.
- An illustration of international Best Practices from different countries, institutions, and jurisdictions
- Practical recommendations for action as voluntary guidance and aid for the respective authorities

III. Key Findings

What are the key findings of the study?

- 87% the authorities surveyed provide support in the implementation of compliance programs.
- Approximately the half of the authorities surveyed take compliance programs into account when calculating the fine reduction.
- Most of the countries surveyed intend to promote compliance efforts yet further in the future.
- 64% of the authorities surveyed, state that they have sufficient resources and know how to promote compliance measures for companies.
- 93 % of the interviewed competition authorities already have cooperation partnerships with other stakeholders.
- All participants have indicated to be interested in a collaboration with potential future cooperation partners in this regard.
