## BACKGROUND: REQUESTS FROM MEMBER STATES

### Agreed conclusions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> session of the IGE Consumer:

10. Emphasizes the importance of regional cooperation in the enforcement of consumer protection law and policy; invites consumer protection authorities to strengthen their bilateral, regional and international cooperation; and **requests the UNCTAD secretariat to explore, gather and promote best practices for international cooperation, in light of guidelines 79 to 94**

### Agreed conclusions of the 16<sup>th</sup> session of the IGE Competition:

11. Requests the UNCTAD secretariat to prepare, in cooperation with other relevant international organizations, a compilation of best practices related to the implementation of competition law and policy, to assist developing countries and countries with economies in transition
