Challenges Facing SMEs I

- SMEs, especially start-ups/entrepreneurs, account for majority of private sector GDP, jobs and growth
- Insights from IFAC SMP Quick Poll
 - Keeping up with standards and regulation is biggest challenge facing SMEs and SMPs
 - Pace of change is aspect of standards and regulation posing greatest challenge for SMEs and SMPs
 - Tax is type of standards and regulation posing greatest challenge for SMEs and SMPs (financial reporting 3rd)
 - Access to finance another key challenge for SMEs



Challenges Facing SMEs II

- SMEs face capacity constraints
 - Lack of in-house knowledge and expertise
 - Strategic, business and technical
 - Struggle to efficiently implement standards
- SMEs typically look to accounting firm, like SMPs, for range of professional services (assurance to advice)



How Accountants Support SMEs

- Assist compliance with regulation
 - Financial reporting, tax etc.
- Facilitate access to finance
 - Accounting
 - Advisory
 - Assurance
- Act as trusted business advisor
- Leverage IT to increase financial capability of SME
 - Could computing
