- One of the objectives of the Partnerships is to support members in preparing for/implementing ISSB standards, what is recommended for this process to be as efficient as possible?

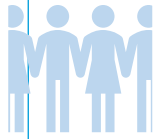


## *Objectives*

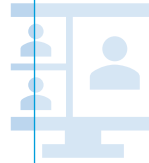
- Establish and/or strengthen the national infrastructure to prepare high-quality sustainability reports by companies
- Measure the contribution of the private sector to the implementation of the SDGs
- Promote sustainable enterprise development
- Provide support in the implementation of international sustainability reporting standards
- Provide a regional voice in interaction with international standard setters
- Promote benchmarking activities between actors, give advice, and stimulate the development of national strategies for the adoption of reporting methodologies
- Promote harmonization in the region by sharing case studies, peer-reviewed experiences and tools to address national challenges



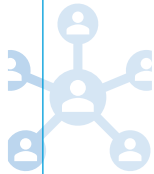
## *Operational mechanisms*



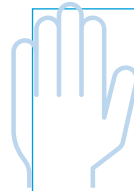
Informal arrangement among 'friends of sustainability reporting'

Two to five entities per country (regulators, standard setters, entities responsible for sustainability reports or SDG implementation, PAO, ...)
