

#### **UNCTAD** activity and Impact

- · Regular activities in 40+ countries, 5 new countries in 2021, several RECs
- 1000+ people attended UNCTAD training courses 50% women
- · Overall budget from extra-budgetary contributions: Around US\$ 4 million
- Donors: AfDB, D, EU, Pacer Plus, TMEA, UK, UN, WBG

#### Impact

- Contributed to accelerated implementation of WTO TFA by assisting more than 15 countries in their notifications and ratification
- UNCTAD Empowerment Program (EP) for National TF Committees capacity building feedback 85% of
  participants feel that they are in a better position to fulfil their NTFC roles and implement TF
- · Gender mainstreaming through training module on Trade Facilitation and Gender
