
CSTD WG on Enhanced Cooperation

Mandate: UNGA Resolution A/Res/67/195 (2012)

- "invites the Chair of CSTD to establish a working group on enhanced cooperation to examine the mandate of WSIS regarding EC, through seeking, compiling and reviewing inputs from all Member States and all other stakeholders, and to make recommendations on how to fully implement this mandate;"
- report to CSTD in 2014

WGEC Working Modalities

- Compliance with the mandate
- Multi-stakeholder approach/mutual trust
- Results based on consensus
- Observers ECOSOC rules apply agreement from WG
- Constraints (time, resources, venue, etc.)
- Information sharing with stakeholders



- Physical meetings in Geneva:
- 1st meeting: 30 May (P.M)-31 May 2013
- Further meetings (3 days each)
 - 2nd meeting: 6-8 November 2013
 - 3rd meeting in 2014 (February 2014)
- Chair's report & recommendations: beginning of March 2014



- Long discussion on Agenda
- Decision on procedural issues
- 2 breakout groups led by Brazil and India identified categories – suggested questions
- Plenary finalized questionnaire based on results of breakout groups
- Decided on next steps



Results of the WGEC 1st Meeting

- Excellent collaboration of participants
- Agreed on modalities of the meeting
 - audio recording /streaming
 - transcript
 - observers' participation
- Drafted questionnaire
 - in accordance with UNGA resolution
 - questions formulated on agreed topics based on WSIS Tunis Agenda




- 18 questions including
