
#### Data Source

- Proposed Documents of Workshops to the IGF, from 2008 to 2013
- Preprocessing
  - Convert to US-English
  - Eliminate Stopwords(NTLK)
  - Word Stemming
  - Eliminate low-frequent words(< 3 sentences)</li>
  - Eliminate too common words
    - 'govern', 'issu', 'workshop', 'internet', 'discuss'

#### Methods

- Dynamic Topic Model [Biel, 2003]
  - Number of Topics: 25
  - $\alpha = 0.01$
  - Number of Cycles: 200





Applying Extended LDA Model ([Biel, 2003] to the Workshop Proposals








### Results (Number of Panelists by Stakeholders)

#### Number of Participants by Stakeholders




# Results (Ratio of Panelists from Stakeholders)


#### Number of Panelists in IGF Workshops 2008-2013 by Organizations





- 技術的な話題に関するワーク ショップ数はほぼほぼ変わってい ない。
- また、アクセシビリティ・多様性 についてもほぼ不変。
- 一方で、開発、法と規制は流行り 廃りがある。
- 開発の増加:ただし、2013年に急に増えていることを踏まえると、(1)開催地域がインドネシアであったためアジア地域からの参加者が増えた、(2)WSIS+10を控えIGFそのものの在り方を問いなおす声が高まった。




- 2008-2009: Many topics are related to "Development"
- 2010-: Topics related to legal issues and regulations are increasing






#### Participation Score Radar Charts by Stakeholders



















## Results (Numbers of Panelists for "Topics" by International Organizations)

Participation Score Radar Charts by Institues











