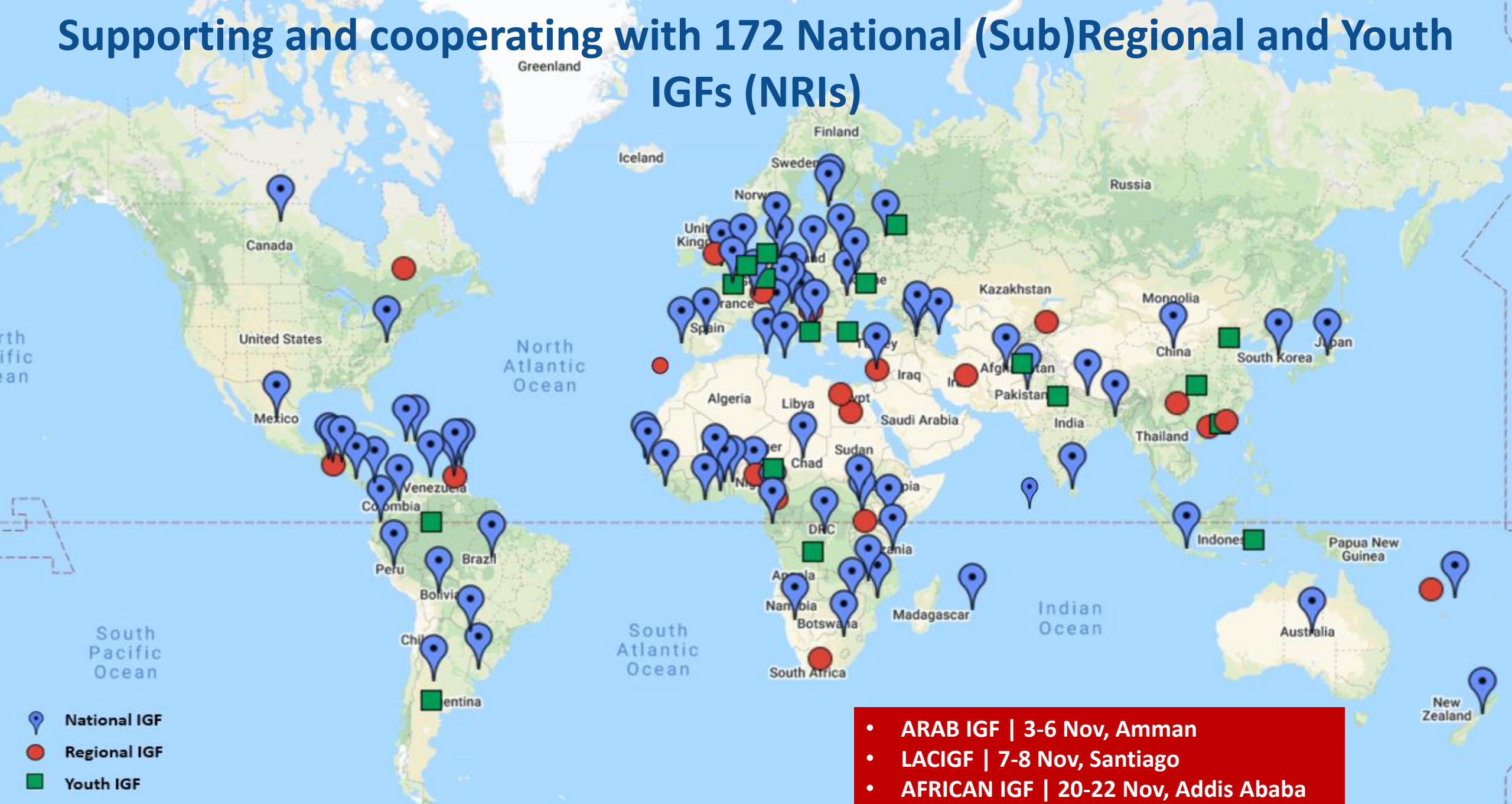

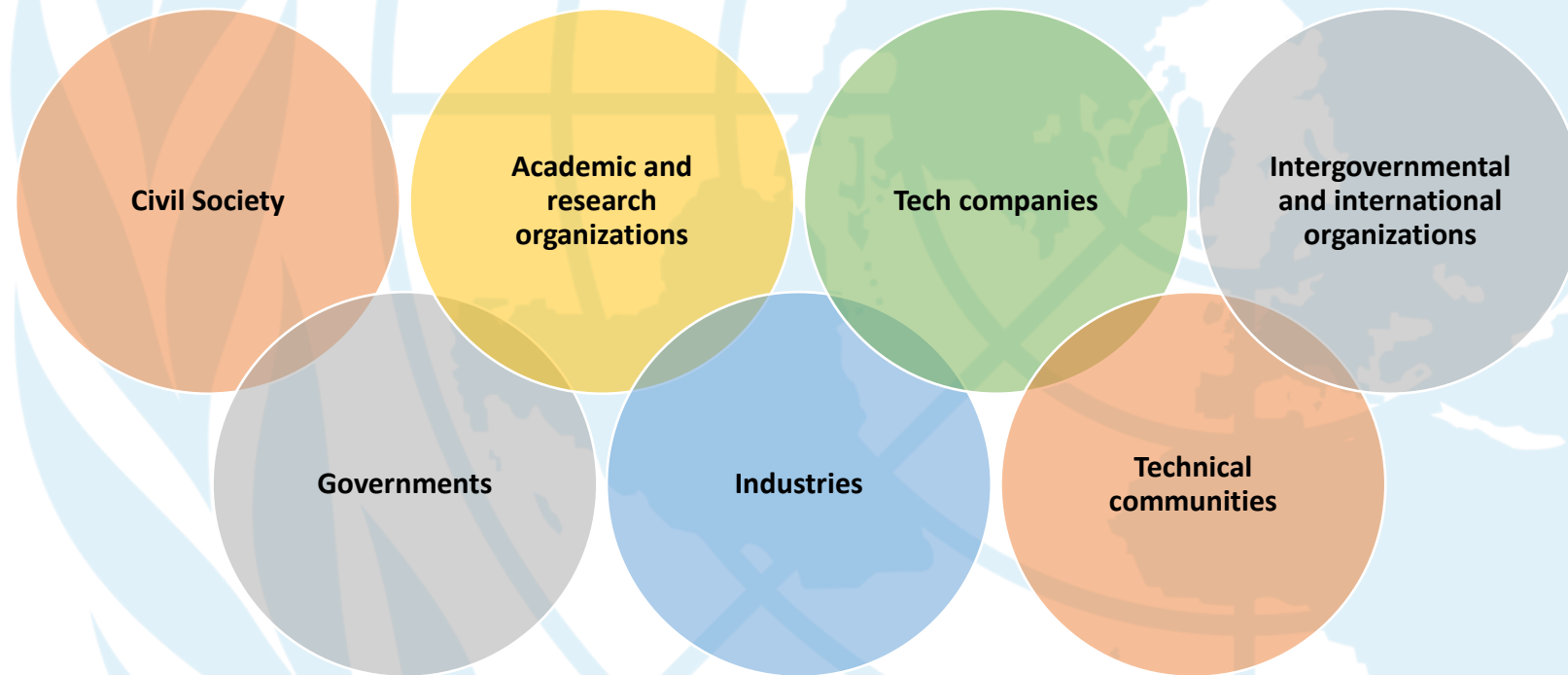

World Summit on the Information Society: 20-year review

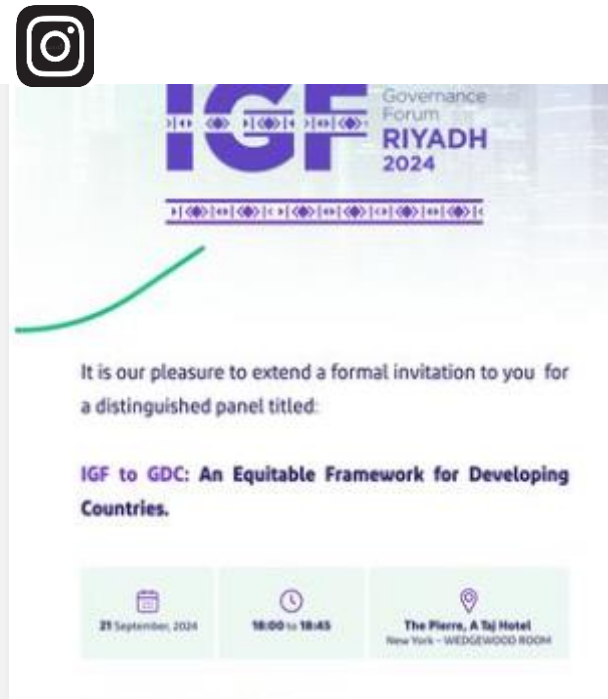
General Assembly Resolution A/70/125 called for a high-level meeting in 2025 to review the overall implementation of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS) outcomes, a process known as the WSIS+20 Review. Currently in its third mandate, the IGF and its extension will once again be a critical aspect of the upcoming WSIS+20 review process in 2025.
