


XITC Cocoa Market Information: Main exporters






XITC Cocoa Market Information: Main importers





Vanuatu's cocoa exports and tariffs: Vanuatu's opportunities






Vanuatu's cocoa exports and non-tariffs measures










Cocoa: Fairtrade: Top 10 countries by area, 2015

The graph presents the area of land cultivated by several countries to produce a certified commodity for one specific Voluntary Sustainability Standard (VSS).




Cocoa: UTZ: Top 10 countries by area

The graph presents the area of land cultivated by several countries to produce a certified commodity for one specific Voluntary Sustainability Standard (VSS).




Cocoa: Rainforest Alliance/SAN: Top 10 countries by area, 2015


Cocoa: Organic: Top 10 countries by area, 2015


















SITC Coconut Market Information: Main exporters






XITC Coconut Market Information: Main importers






SITC Vanuatu's coconuts' exports and non-tariffs measures




