








Figure 4: Figure 4: Remittance Flows to Low-and Middle-Income Countries Expected to Decline in 2020 (Source: World Bank) 10




Figure 15: 2020 Forecast for International Tourism Receipts and Previous Global Crises (Source: WTO)

#### Cruise Vessel Movements




Figure 16: The percent of total time not moving has jumped from an average of 20% to more than 60% for vessels larger than 10,000 gross tonnes. (Source: IHS Markit)

#### Contribution of Tourism to Employment and GDP




Figure 17: Percentage Share of Total Employment 2018 (Source: World Travel & Tourism Council Data Gateway)




Figure 18: Percentage Share of Total Contribution to GDP 2018 (Source: World Travel & Tourism Council)

#### Impact Assessment and Limits

Challenges with an immediate assessment include the lack of reliable data from industry and Central Government

#### **Observed Impacts**

- Tourism: Complete closure of the sector
- Manufacturing: Closure of the Sector [with few exceptions]
- Agriculture: Reduced activity in the sector
- Social Sector: Health and Educational impacts both severely impacted


