## Trade and Biodiversity (TraBio) statistical tool

(UNCTAD BioTrade Initiative and Statistics Service

### **Objective**

- provide information on trade in biodiversity-based products
- enable a better understanding of the significance of trade in products with a biological origin; e.g. formulate and review policies
- gather, report and monitor progress on national & international policies & development processes; e.g. KM GBF, SDGs



internationally recognized standard for BD-related trade statistics (harmonize concepts and data used)



## **TraBio Components**


Component 1: A product list and a product classification of biodiversity-based goods that is the universe of biodiversity-based products included in the TraBio statistical tool

Component 2: A database containing data on annual trade flows of biodiversity-based products & trade indicators since 2010 (for online & download)



Component 3: a set of interactive visualisation tools (e.g. maps and charts)




### **Content of TraBio statistical tool**

- Based on the Harmonized System (HS)
- All products with a biological origin (terrestrial and aquatic )
- UNCTAD expertise, pilot exercise, extensive desk research & expert consultations and webinars

#### Considerations:

- intrinsically and integrally based on biological resources at a non- or low-processed stage (e.g. cocoa beans)
- solely or principally use biological resources-based ingredients or products as inputs in their production processes (e.g. cotton shirts, wooden furniture)
- derived mainly from biological resources-based products, such as soap containing glycerol from animal fats
- excluded certain products considered as "natural products" without having a biological origin (e.g. metals or products derived from the extraction of minerals)










Export growth of biodiversity-based products in 2021




### ....To regional, national, and by product level

Trade in biodiversity-based products in selected ASEAN countries (2021)




#### Trade in biodiversity-based products as a %GDP





Average share of biodiversity-based products in the annual GDP and export trade for ASEAN member states from 2010 to 2020.




Share of biodiversity-based products in export for selected ASEAN countries and average for all during 2010 to 2020.




Exports of biodiversity-based products (2021)

### Product concentration of exports (2021)








