



Some recommendations

- Collaborate on definitions and classifications across institutions
- Create links with other databases and ongoing initiatives
- Build capacity for improved data gathering, coverage and analysis
- Involve policy-makers, MEA Secretariats, UN agencies, academia
- Provide recommendations on changes to HS system
