

### Main OUTPUTS so far:

- the Open Working Group proposed 17 specific goals with 169 associated targets
- **The UN SG Synthesis Report** The road to dignity by 2030: ending poverty, transforming all lives and protecting the planet
- The High-levelPanel of Eminent Persons on the Post-2015 Development Agenda called for five "transformative shifts"
- The Intergovernmental Committee of Experts on Sustainable Development Financing proposed a basket of more than 100 options for policymakers, together with recommendations for a global
- The Sustainable Development Solutions Network recommended the adoption of a science-based and action-oriented agenda, integrating four interdependent dimensions of sustainable devel.
- "A World That Counts" by Independent Expert Advisory Group on the Data Revolution for Sustainable Development



TARGETS

13.2 integrate climate change measures into national policies, strategies, and planning

13.3 improve education, awareness raising and human and institutional capacity on climate change mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction, and early warning

13.a implement the commitment undertaken by developed country Parties to the UNFCCC to a goal of mobilizing jointly USD100 billion annually by 2020 from all sources to address the needs of developing countries in the context of meaningful mitigation actions and transparency on implementation and fully operationalize the Green Climate Fund through its capitalization as soon as possible

13.b Promote mechanisms for raising capacities for effective climate change related planning and management, in LDCs, including focusing on women, youth, local and marginalized communities
