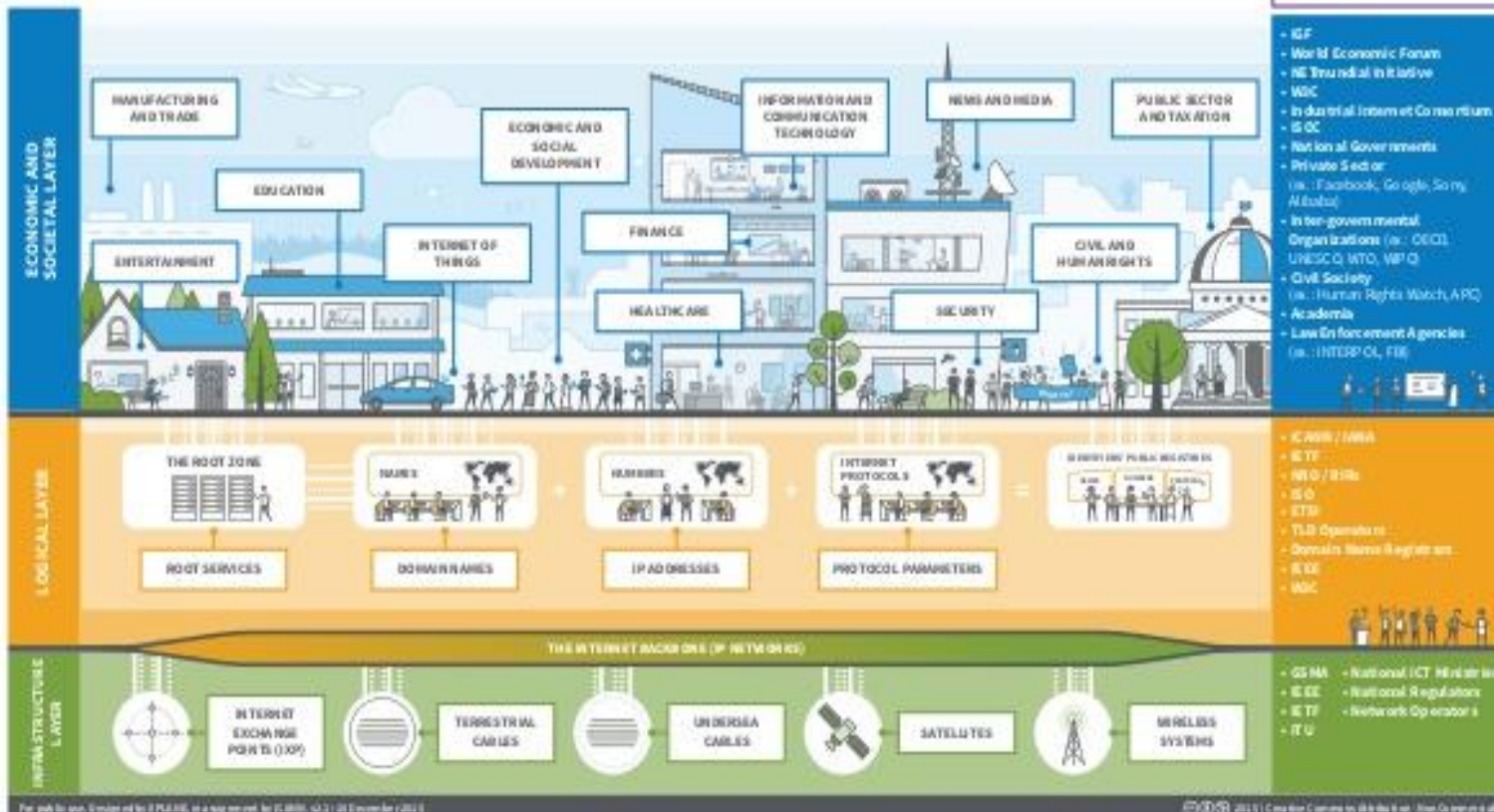

No one person, government, organization, or company governs the digital space. Digital Governance may be stratified into three layers depicted here: Infrastructure, Logical, and Societal. Solutions to issues in each layer include policies, best practices, standards, specifications, and tools developed by the collaborations of stakeholders and experts from actors in business, government, academia, technical, and civil society.
