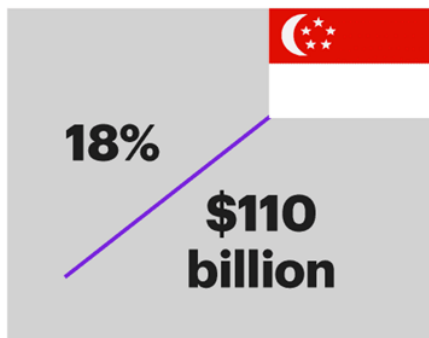

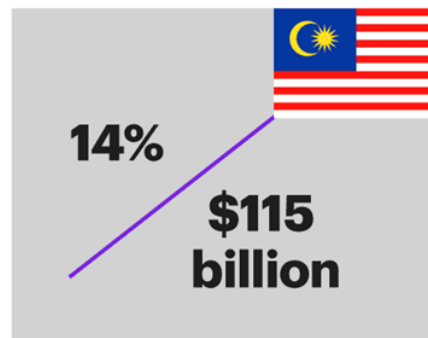


Estimated USD 1 Trillion in GDP Growth by 2030

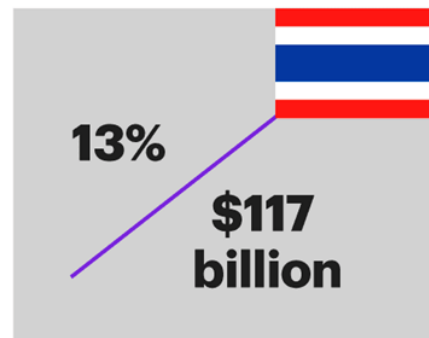

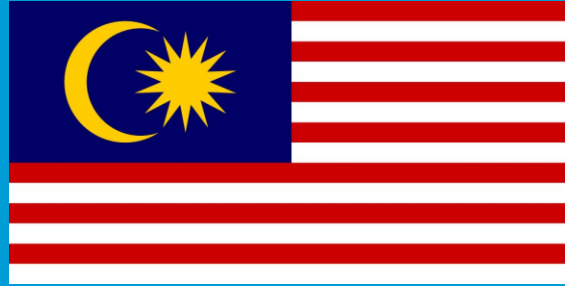
Report Recommendations

1. Create specific guidelines on gender and AI
2. Establish committees and task forces to lead gender/societal impact assessments
3. Develop gender-sensitive AI standards
4. Invest in efforts that accelerate women's participation in AI
