






Al in Southeast Asia





- Establish committees and task forces to lead gender/societal impact assessments
- 3. Develop gender-sensitive Al standards
- 4. Invest in efforts that accelerate women's participation in Al

Project Takeaways

- 1. Need for continued information sharing and capacity building on gender-sensitive and socially inclusive Al
- 2. Need for integrated, intersectional, and inclusive approaches to Al
- 3. Need to actively counter AI risks to women and vulnerable groups
- Need for continued investment in women/girls/minorities/groups' participation in and ownership of AI
- 5. Need for partnerships and collaborative approaches
