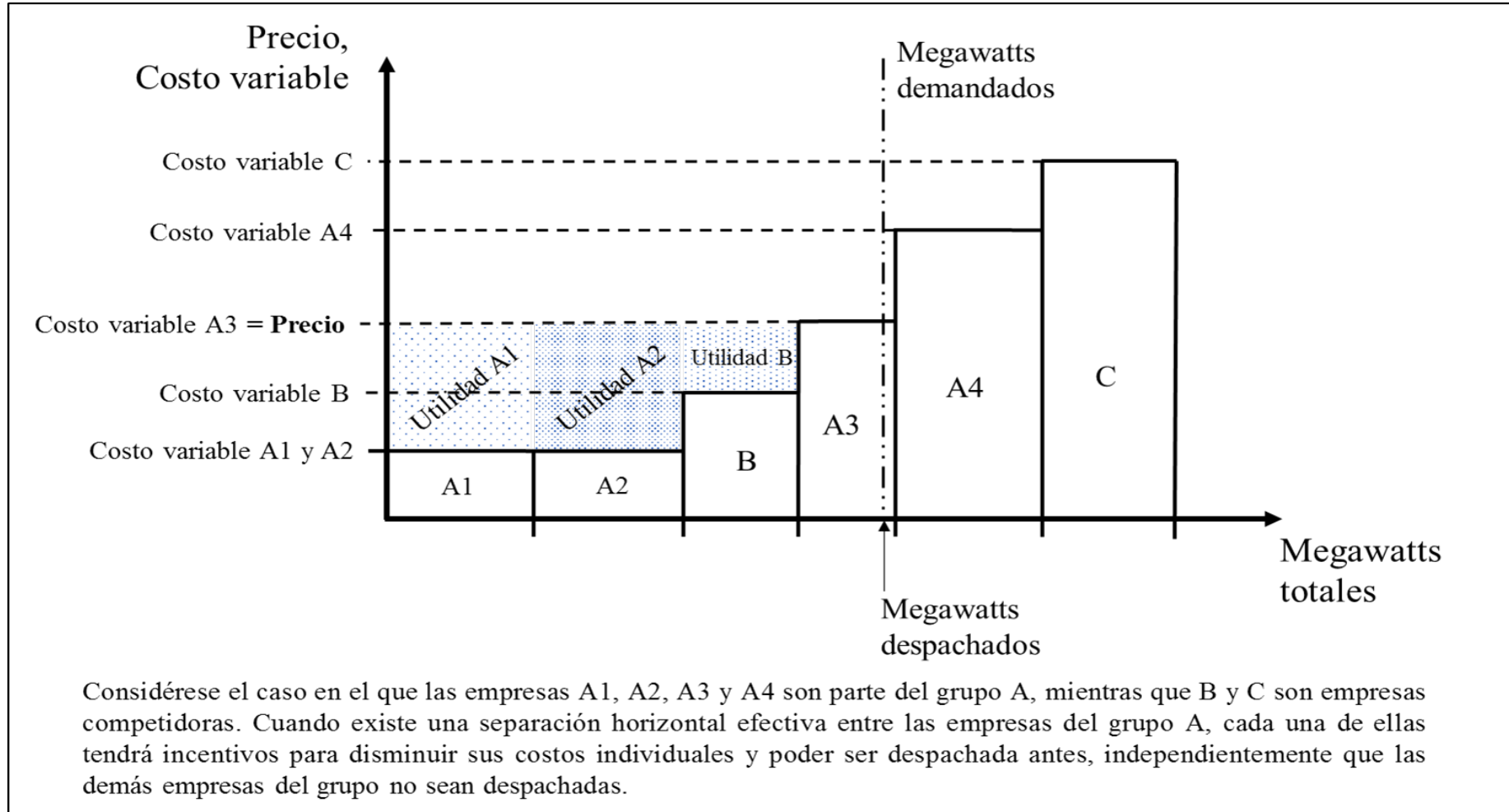

Opinions, non-binding character, swift procedure, public position, amicus curiae.



Constitutional controversy, might result in binding recommendations, depends on Supreme Court decision, only applies if a norm may cause institution's faculties to overlap. (might take a year or more).



Barriers to competition, binding recommendations, investigation takes more than a year, Congress has issued new laws rendering Cofece's recommendation obsolete.
