



World primary energy and unit of energy per GDP




- "To limit warming to 1.5°C, the world requires three times more renewable energy capacity by 2030, and must double the global average annual rate of energy efficiency improvements from around 2% to over 4% every year until 2030"
- Energy efficiency was not 2% CAGR in 2012-2022 but only 1.5%!
- Energy efficiency improvement is decreasing massively since the 1970s...

2035 world energy mix?





Value chain of US LNG sold to EU, Dec. 2023 vs EU subsidies 2022







Polluters pay principle

 At 80€/t for EU Allowances, shipping industry could pay €6.3bn/year for CO₂ emissions alone!



- Major changes in ship building orders:
 - CMA-CGM's decided, in 2023, to switch its order for eight methanol dual-fuelled ships to LNG dual-fuelled.
 - In July 2024, Carnival, the largest global cruise company, announced again an order for three new LNG-fuelled ships.
 - In August 2024, Maersk changed its tune on LNG with big ship order.
- If all ships in the EEA were running on LNG, we would have an extra LNG demand of 35 mt (9% of worldwide LNG supply) and the associated CO₂ emissions would be reduced by 24%.
