Overview: The UN Trade and Development (UNCTAD) and its role in the industry

- As a permanent intergovernmental body established by the United Nations General Assembly in 1964
- As part of the UN Secretariat: We report to the UN General
 Assembly and the Economic and Social Council but have our own membership, leadership, and budget (195 Members)
- As the UN focal point for trade, development, investment and transfer of technology
- Our trade-related aspects of SDG 14 and its implementation
 mandate

UNCTAD is the <u>only</u> entity within the UN system with an **ocean trade database** (goods and services)





History of collaboration: Key milestones and significant projects between UNCTAD and FAO GLOBEFISH

- Joint UNCTAD-FAO-UNEP voluntary commitment to assist Member States in the implementation of effective and inclusive policies for Sustainable Trade in fisheries UNOC-1 (2017)
- UNCTAD-FAO as the co-leading agency of the Informal Working Group on Fisheries Management and Trade: UNOC 1, 2 and 3 (2017-2022)
- Inter-Agency Plan of Action for the implementation of trade-related aspects of SDG 14 by UNCTAD, FAO and UNEP (2019-25)
- Organization of four United Nations Oceans Fora on trade-related aspects of SDG 14 in Geneva: UNCTAD, FAO, UNEP, OACPS, Commonwealth, CAF and IOI (2017-2024)













Achievements and impacts of the UNCTAD-FAO collaboration
