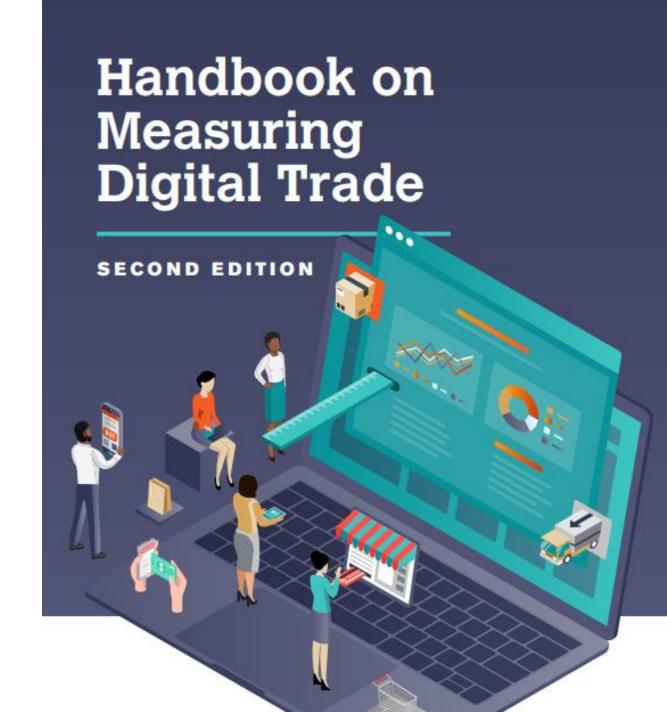

- Mission (Nov 2025): raising stakeholder awareness of the initiative, discussions on user needs and data sources
- → working together towards establishing the way forward

UNCTAD technical cooperation is demand-led

- How to request:
- 1. Initial contact: please message emeasurement@unctad.org giving an overview of the support you are seeking on behalf of your country or region
- 2. Clarification: we work together with you to clarify the scope of the request and how we can best meet your needs
- 3. Formal request: we will support you through the process of making a formal request addressed to the Secretary General of UN Trade and Development
- **4. Fund raising (if needed):** if the initiative cannot be funded by the beneficiary or by UNCTAD, work together to identify potential funding sources
- **5. Plan and execute delivery** (often in phases for TA)

Note: if the request is better addressed by one of our partner IOs, we will facilitate contact with them
