

## > Statistics Service ToR



- Provide high-quality data and statistics on trade and development UNCTADstat, HBS, SDG Pulse
- ▶ Coordinate data and statistical activities in UNCTAD Statistics Coordination Committee (data ethics, standards, SQAS)
- Provide insights from data and statistics with innovative methods New thematics insights, data visualizations, weekly nowcasts, etc.
- Develop national statistical capacity and global statistics New statistics, methods, standards and data skills



### > E-learning in trade statistics



- By Statistics service with TrainForTrade, UNSD and WTO
- 2 courses on Merchandise trade and Trade in services
  - knowledge and skills to understand and compile trade statistics
  - Online lectures in EN and FR, interactive forum, a manual, quizzes, with a workshop or webinar
- Global coverage (88% developing, 12% developed) Almost 14 000 trained people since 2016 with more than 2 250 in 2024 of which 46% are women
- Among top participants China, Indonesia, Philippines, India, Cameroon, Mexico, Haiti, Togo





- ▶ XB Project (2015-2021), UNCTAD and UEMOA Commission
- ▶ Modular IT system to collect/process trade in services statistics
- Version 1.4 deployed in several UEMOA members Next survey in Benin, Côte d'Ivoire, and Senegal
- ▶ UNDA project started in 2024 7 CARICOM countries With ECLAC and partners
- Strong interest among Gulf countries
- ▶ At no cost except for training, maintenance, and support

## > Illicit financial flows (IFFs)



- UNCTAD and UNODC Custodians of SDG indicator 16.4.1 Conceptual framework and Methodological Guidelines
- ▶ 22 member States on 3 continents pilot tested IFF measurement with first official <u>estimates</u> available Significant IFFs from trade misinvoicing, effective policy action
- ▶ UNDA project (2023-2026) supports 8 beneficiary countries ECA, UNCTAD, UNODC, Regional Commissions
- Need for project resources to empower countries to track and curb IFFs
  - Over 40 countries requested support



## South-South Cooperation



- UNCTAD co-custodian of SDG indicator 17.3.1 for SSC IFT, hosted by OECD, co-custodian for North-South flows
- Voluntary Framework to measure South-South cooperation By the global South, adopted by the UN Statistical Commission, Non-financial support is essential to South-South cooperation
- ▶ UNDA project (2023-2026) supports 8 countries UNCTAD, UNSD, ECA, ECLAC, ESCAP, ESCWA
- ▶ 60 countries asked for technical support and tools from UNCTAD! First-ever globally inclusive information on development support by including data on South-South cooperation owned and reported by the Southern countries in their own Framework

## > Transport cost dataset



- Analytical dataset on transport costs for international trade by mode of transport, 2022-2024 By UNCTAD Statistics & DTL, World Bank, IMO
- Supports related research and analysis
  - Calculation of emissions from transport related to international trade in goods
  - Monitor the resilience of the maritime and logistical system and the impact on the cost of trade for LDCs



## Gender equality in trade



- ▶ UNCTAD's new gender equality in trade indicators
  - Methods developed in UNDA project in Africa and Eastern Europe
  - Women only produce between 20% and 40% of total export value
  - Services trade offers increasing potential for women's economic empowerment
- ▶ Framework and Guidelines for measuring gender in trade Now part of global Trade and Business Statistics manuals
- Currently no project funding available to expand this work to other countries
