1. INTRODUCTION

The agenda of the Russian Competition Week will include sessions of International


Working Groups on research of competition issues in the ICT sector, in the pharmaceutical sector, as well as on global food value chains.

Within the framework of the Russian Competition Week, the International Round Table on Combating Cartels will be organized, at which participants once again will be able not only discuss how to combat agreements restricting competition, but also conduct investigation of hypothetic cartel case in an interesting game format.

Traditionally, a key moment of the Russian Competition Week's agenda will be the Plenary Session the main topic of which will be "Competition policy in the digital era".

It is worth mention that the Plenary Session will be organized in a historical place located in the heart of the city – in beautiful halls of the Arensky Philharmonic of Novgorod on the territory of the Novgorod Kremlin.

This leaflet contains general information on the Event, transport logistics, as well as background information that may be useful to you.



Veliky Novgorod is the ancient city of Russia, large medieval center of trade and craft, city-museum. It is here where first Russian books were written and first birch bark manuscripts — documents written on pieces of the inner layer of birch bark, monuments of writing of Ancient Russia of 11th-15th centuries — are found.

Novgorod Kremlin (also Detinets) is the object of the world cultural heritage UNESCO included in Novgorod Museum-reserve. The Philharmonic, regional scientific library and the school of music are located on the territory of Kremlin. Festivals, celebratory events and exhibitions are held in Detinets.

Cathedral of St. Sophia is one of the most outstanding monuments of ancient Russian architecture. It is the oldest surviving ancient Russian cathedral on the territory of Russia built by Prince Vladimir, the son of Yaroslav the Wise in 1045-1050.

Since ancient times Novgorod has been divided on 'Sophia' and 'Trade' sides connected to each other by a single pedestrian bridge - the Trade Bridge. While the architectural center of the Sophia side of Novgorod has always been the Detinets, the same role on the Trade side belonged to the architectural ensemble **Yaroslav's court**, located on the right bank of Volkhov river.

One of the most interesting buildings of the late Soviet period of Veliky Novgorod history is the **Novgorod Academic Drama Theatre named after F. Dostoevsky** built in 1987. The building of the theatre is a bright example of Soviet modernist architecture.

The restaurant have a picturesque view on the famous Volkhov river which is among the sightseeing places of Veliky Novgorod. It is a historical place associated with the times of the origin of statehood in Russia. Here you will further feel the beauty of Russian nature described in Russian and foreign literature so often.

On the evening of 20 September 2017, a reception on behalf of the FAS Russia will be organized in a ballroom of the Novgorod Philharmonic, named after prominent Russian composer, pianist and conductor Anton Arensky, who was native of the Novgorod Province.

In the framework of the excursion program this year the FAS Russia offers to visit Novgorod Kremlin – the main sightseeing place of the city. This is one of the oldest monuments of military-defensive architecture of Russia in XV-XVII centuries.

The Kremlin includes the oldest Church in Russia - St. Sophia Cathedral. On the cross of its central dome, there is a sculpture of a dove, the legend of which, as well as interesting facts related to the history of Cathedral you can learn while visiting the excursion.

We will inform you about date and time of the excursion additionally.

In case you decide to enjoy a guided tour by yourself, you can make use of the services of the "Beresta Travel" tour desk, which is located directly in the Park Inn Hotel.

Climate of Veliky Novgorod is temperate continental. Winter lasts from the middle of November until the beginning of April. Fall is rather soft and long. Average air temperature in September is +10.3 degrees. The monthly rainfall in September is about 60 mm.

Smoking is permitted only in specially designated areas.



Official currency of the Russian Federation is Russian ruble. There is a set of currency exchange offices in Veliky Novgorod. The main exchange currencies are US dollar and euro. The exchange rate depends on policy of bank. At currency exchange it is necessary to have a passport. The exchange rate of foreign currencies is: $1 \text{ USD} \approx 61 \text{ RUB}$; $1 \text{ EUR} \approx 71 \text{ RUB}$.
