Item 3: Policies and programmes for technology development and mastery, including the role of FDI

- 3. At its seventh session, held in Geneva from 24 to 27 February 2003, the Commission on Enterprise, Business Facilitation and Development decided to convene an Expert Meeting on Policies and Programmes for Technology Development and Mastery, including the Role of FDI.
- 4. As agreed by the Commission, this Expert Meeting will discuss policy options conducive to moving up the technology ladder, including for technology transfer, development and mastery in order to meet international quality standards, as well as financial and fiscal measures to promote collective action among the actors (home and host Governments, support agencies, and large and small firms) for "linking, leveraging and learning".
- 5. The aim is to identify policies and programmes that have allowed some countries to move up the technology ladder, as well as to identify the main constraints and obstacles that have hindered development in other countries. The outcome of the Expert Meeting will be directly relevant to the UNCTAD XI themes.
- 6. To facilitate the discussions, the UNCTAD secretariat has prepared an issues note entitled "Policies and programmes for technology development and mastery, including the role of FDI". Further, a background document will be circulated during the Meeting containing six detailed country studies. In addition, experts are encouraged to prepare brief papers on the subject under discussion. These papers will be made available at the meeting in the form and language in which they are received. Panels will be organized to bring together three to four experts on each issue to launch the discussion.
