# Item 3: Development of multimodal transport and logistics services

- 3. At its seventh session, the Commission on Enterprise, Business Facilitation and Development decided to convene an Expert Meeting on the Development of Multimodal Transport and Logistics Services. Multimodal transport and logistics services are essential for the development of international trade, but they are not widely available in developing countries, because local service providers tend to lack the capacity to reach overseas markets, and because existing infrastructure, technologies and institutional and legal frameworks are often inadequate to allow efficient linkages with global operators. The Expert Meeting will review and explore the impact of the latest developments in multimodal transport and logistics on developing countries, as well as the challenges and opportunities that these developments provide for them, including small island, landlocked and least developed countries.
- 4. The Expert Meeting will analyse the determinants of inexpensive and high-quality transport and logistics services, and identify main areas for possible service improvements. It will assess market developments, as well as the impact of operational, legal and regulatory developments, including the implementation of recent security measures, on the ability of developing countries to participate in the provision of such services. The Meeting is expected to discuss proposals for necessary action aimed at improving the situation of developing countries as both users and suppliers of multimodal transport and logistics services.
- 5. To facilitate the discussions, the UNCTAD secretariat has prepared an issues note on recent developments in multimodal transport and logistics services, and problems encountered by developing countries (TD/B/COM.3/EM.20/2). In addition, experts are

encouraged to prepare brief papers on the subject under discussion. These papers will be made available at the meeting in the form and language in which they are received.
