United Nations Cocoa Conference, 2010

Geneva, 21–25 June 2010

Report of the Credentials Committee

- 1. At its first plenary meeting, on 21 June 2010, the United Nations Cocoa Conference, 2010 appointed a Credentials Committee. The membership of the Committee was as follows: Côte d'Ivoire, Ecuador, Ghana, Ireland* and Spain.
- 2. The Credentials Committee met on 24 June 2010.
- 3. Ms. Marie-Claude **DEGNI-SEGUI** (Côte d'Ivoire) chaired the meeting.
- 4. The UNCTAD secretariat informed the Committee of the status of credentials of representatives as at 23 June 2010. As provided for in rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference, credentials for the Conference had been submitted to the Secretary-General of UNCTAD by 45 States.
- 5. The Chair proposed that the Committee accept the credentials of the representatives of the member States referred to in paragraph 4. In connection with the credentials that had not yet been submitted in due form, the Chair proposed that the Committee accept the assurances given by the representatives concerned, on the understanding that their credentials would be submitted promptly to the Secretary-General of UNCTAD. There was no objection to this proposal.
- 6. The Chair then proposed that the Committee should recommend to the Conference the adoption of the following draft resolution:

"Credentials of Representatives to the United Nations Cocoa Conference, 2010

The United Nations Cocoa Conference, 2010;

Approves the report of the Credentials Committee."

7. The Committee endorsed the above proposal without a vote.
