OTHER BUSINESS

Draft decision submitted by Bangladesh, coordinator of the least developed countries

The Trade and Development Board,

<u>Reafffirming</u> the role of UNCTAD as the focal point within the UN system for coordinating LDC-related issues.

Recalling the outcome of UNCTAD X as it relates to LDCs,

Recalling further General Assembly resolution 54/235 on the Third United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries, to be hosted by the European Union in Brussels during the period 13 \square 20 May 2001,

<u>Emphasizing</u> the importance of integrating LDC-related issues into the work of the intergovernmental machinery and that of the UNCTAD secretariat,

1. <u>Decides</u> to establish a standing intergovernmental body to deal with the overall monitoring of progress in the implementation of policies and measures in favour of LDCs,

- 2. <u>Decides further</u> that such a body will meet at least twice a year to (a) deal, during the spring session, with substantive policy issues which have a bearing on the socio-economic development of LDCs, including sectoral and thematic issues; and (b) monitor, during the autumn session, progress in the outcome of the Third United Nations Conference on LDCs and other related programmes of action,
- 3. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General of UNCTAD to ensure that all core Divisions in the secretariat provide relevant substantive inputs for the consideration of the standing body to be established.
