# **SUMMARY OF MEETINGS**

#### 20 October 1999

Sessional Committee II <u>1st Meeting</u>

<u>UNCTAD's contribution to the implementation of the United Nations New Agenda for the Development of Africa in the 1990s</u>

The Committee elected its Vice-Chairman-cum-Rapporteur, Ms. Ingrid Mollestad (Norway). The Chairman, H.E. Mr. Adolphe NAHAYO (Burundi), made a short opening statement on the item. Mr. Rubens Ricupero, Secretary-General of UNCTAD, addressed the Committee, and Mr. Kamran Kousari, UNCTAD Coordinator for Africa, made an introductory statement.

Statements were made by the following representatives: Nigeria (on behalf of the African Group); Cuba (on behalf of the Latin America and Caribbean Group); India (on behalf of the Asian Group); the United States of America; the Organization of African Unity (OUA); Japan; Madagascar; Burundi; Poland; China; South Africa and Finland (on behalf of the European Union).

The Committee continued its consideration of item 5 with a statement from the representative of Norway, thus concluding the general debate. The rest of the meeting was informal.
