1. The Trade and Development Board, at its sixteenth executive session, on 16 February 1998, approved the application of two non-governmental organizations for designation under rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board.

Also at this session, the Board took note that the Baltic Exchange, a non-governmental organization in status with the Board in the special category since the first part of its thirty-ninth session, had informed the secretariat that, since UNCTAD's work was no longer of direct relevance to the Exchange, it should be deleted from the list provided for in rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board.

4. Accordingly, the number of non-governmental organizations included in the list now totals 177: 95 in the <u>General category</u> and 82 in the <u>Special category</u>. There are 10 national non-governmental organizations included in the <u>Register</u>.
