# First Plenary meeting

<u>Item 5</u> <u>Economic development in Africa: The role of foreign direct investment in growth and development</u>

Mr. Kamran Kousari, Special Coordinator for Africa, made an introductory statement with reference to the report *Economic Development in Africa*.

The general debate was opened. The following representatives made general statements: Democratic Republic of the Congo (on behalf of the Group of 77 and China); Egypt (on behalf of the African Group); Cuba (on behalf of the Latin American and Caribbean Group); Indonesia (on behalf of the Asian Group and China); Benin (on behalf of the least developed countries); United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (on behalf of the European Union and acceding countries Bulgaria and Romania); Islamic Republic of Iran; China; Norway; Nigeria; Ethiopia; Japan; Chad; South Africa; and African Union.
