## Summary of meetings Friday, 23 September 2011

### 1081st closing plenary meeting

### Item 5 Implementation of the outcome from LDC-IV: UNCTAD's contribution

The Chair of Sessional Committee I, Mr. Wolfgang Rechenhofer of Germany, presented his report to the Board.

The Board took note of the report of Sessional Committee I as contained in document TD/B/58/SC.1/L.1 and endorsed the agreed conclusions in document TD/B/58/SC.1/L.1.

Item 15 (a) Report by the President of the Advisory Body set up in accordance with paragraph 166 of the Bangkok Plan of Action on the implementation of courses by the secretariat in 2010–2011 and their relevant impact; and the appointment of members of the Advisory Body for 2012

The Board took note of the report of the Advisory Body as contained in TD/B/58/CRP.4.

The Board approved the membership of the Advisory Body for 2012 as follows: H.E. Mr. Maung Wai (Myanmar), H.E. Mr. Dinesh Bhattarai (Nepal), H.E. Mr. Yahya Al-Wahaibi (Oman), H.E. Mr. Idriss Jazairy (Algeria), H.E. Mr. Shree Baboo Chekitan Servansing (Mauritius), H.E. Mr. Murad Najafbayli (Azerbaijan), H.E. Mr. Aziz Pölozhani (former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia), H.E. Mr. Mario Matus (Chile) and H.E. Mr. Roberto Flores Bermudez (Honduras).

(b) Designation of non-governmental organizations for the purpose of rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board

There were no new applications before the Board. A list of the 114 intergovernmental organizations in status with UNCTAD was before the board I document TD/B/IGO/LIST/8.

(c) Designation of non-governmental organizations for the purposes of rule 77 of the rules of procedure of the Board

There were no new applications before the Board. A list of the 201 non-governmental organizations in status with UNCTAD was before the Board in document TD/B/NGO/LIST/12.

### (d) Review of the calendar of meetings

The Board approved the calendar of meetings for the remainder of 2011 and the indicative calendar for 2012 contained in document TD/B/58/CRP.1.

### (e) Membership of the Working Party for 2012

The Board approved the membership of the Working Party for 2011 as follows: Albania, Belarus, Chile, China, Ethiopia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Kenya, Mexico, Nepal, Niger, Peru, Russian Federation and Viet Nam. It is noted that nominations still had to be received from Group B.

# (f) Review of the lists of States contained in the annex to General Assembly resolution 1995 (XIX)

The Board welcomed South Sudan as a member of UNCTAD. The updated membership list was before the Board in TD/B/INF.222.

### (g) Administrative and financial implications of the actions of the Board

The Board was informed that there were no financial implications arising from the work of its current session.

### **Item 16** Adoption of the report on Credentials

The Board adopted the report of the Bureau on the credentials of representatives participating in the fifty-sixth session of the Board, as contained in TD/B/58/L.2.

### Item 17 Provisional agenda for the fifty-ninth session of the Board.
