H.E. Mr. Triyono Wibowo (Indonesia), President of the Board, made opening remarks on agenda items 4 and 8.

Mr. Mukhisa Kituyi, Secretary-General of UNCTAD, made an introductory statement on agenda items 4 and 8. This was followed by a statement by Mr. Alfredo Calcagno, Officer-in-Charge of the Division on Globalization and Development Strategies.

General statements

Statements were made by representatives of the following member States: Ecuador (on behalf of the Group of 77 and China), the European Union, El Salvador (on behalf of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States), Iraq (on behalf of the Asian Group), Ethiopia (on behalf of the African Group), Benin (on behalf of least developed countries), China, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Indonesia, Honduras, the Philippines, Thailand, Sudan and Argentina.

These were followed by remarks by Mr. Alfredo Calcagno, Officer-in-Charge of the Division on Globalization and Development Strategies.

The Board continued its consideration of item 4 with a panel discussion.
