# Item 8 Development strategies in a globalized world: Growing domestic and regional demand for balanced and sustainable growth

The Board continued its consideration of item 8 with a panel discussion. Mr. Petko Draganov, Deputy Secretary-General of UNCTAD, made opening remarks on the agenda. Mr. Alfredo Calcagno, Officer-in-Charge of the Division on Globalization and Development Strategies, presented the *Trade and Development Report, 2013*. Presentations were made by the following panellists: Mr. Ha-Joon Chang, Reader in the Political Economy of Development at the University of Cambridge, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; Mr. Nimrod Zalk, Industrial Development Policy and Strategy Adviser, Department of Trade and Industry, South Africa; Mr. Edgardo Torija Zane, Senior Manager of International Agreements, Central Bank, Argentina.
