Thursday, 18 September 2014

Sessional Committee II – First plenary meeting

Item 6 Economic development in Africa: Catalysing investment for transformative growth in Africa

Sessional Committee II was opened by the Committee's Chairperson, H.E. Ms. Yvette Stevens (Sierra Leone). The Committee elected Mr. Herman Hermoso (the Philippines) as Vice-Chairperson-cum-Rapporteur.

Sessional Committee II began is consideration of agenda item 6, with an opening statement by Mr. Mukhisa Kituyi, Secretary-General of UNCTAD. Mr. Taffere Tesfachew, Director, Division for Africa, Least Developed Countries and Special Programmes introduced the reports by the UNCTAD secretariat.

Statements were made by the following representatives: Chad (on behalf of the Group of 77 and China); the Philippines (on behalf of the Asian Group); the United Republic of Tanzania (on behalf of the African Group); Benin (on behalf of the least developed countries); Brazil (on behalf of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States); the European Union (on behalf of the European Union and its member States); Zimbabwe; Algeria; Thailand; Cuba; China; South Africa; Egypt; United States of America; United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; Morocco; Angola and Japan. A statement also was made on behalf of the African, Caribbean, and Pacific Group of States secretariat.

Sessional Committee II continued consideration of agenda item 6 in an informal meeting with the participation of panellists. Mr. Mukhisa Kituyi, Secretary-General of UNCTAD, made opening remarks on the agenda. Presentations were made by the following panellists: H.E. Ms. Fatima Haram Acyl, Commissioner for Trade and Industry, African Union Commission; Ms. Caroline Kende-Robb, Executive Director, Africa Progress Panel; and Mr. Stephen Gelb, Director and Senior Research Fellow, University of Bern.
