Plenary meeting

Item 7 Evolution of the international trading system and its trends from a development perspective

The Board began its consideration of this item with opening remarks by Mr. Mukhisa Kituyi, Secretary-General of UNCTAD.

Mr. Roberto Azevêdo, Director-General of the World Trade Organization made a presentation.

The following representatives made interactive comments: the Philippines, Benin, Morocco, the secretariat of the African, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States and the European Union.

Mr. Kituyi and Mr. Azevêdo replied to the comments made by the above-mentioned delegations.

Mr. Guillermo Valles, Director, UNCTAD Division on International Trade in Goods and Services, and Commodities, presented the background document under this agenda item.

This was followed by presentations by the following panellists: Mr. Crawford Falconer, Deputy Director, Division for Trade and Agriculture, Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development; Mr. Jamie Morrison, Senior Economist, Trade and Markets Division, Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations; and Ms. Miriam Chaves, Chair, Agriculture Committee, World Trade Organization.

Statements were delivered by the following representatives: the Philippines, on behalf of the Group of 77 and China; Argentina, on behalf of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean Countries; the European Union, on behalf of the European Union and its member States; Uzbekistan; Barbados; Algeria; Morocco; and the Philippines. The Director of the Division on International Trade in Goods and Services, and Commodities and the panellists made concluding remarks and responded to comments by delegations.
