

Item 1

Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

1. The provisional agenda of the seventy-sixth executive session of the Trade and Development Board was approved by members of the Trade and Development Board through a silence procedure that ended on 25 July 2024. The provisional agenda for the session is reproduced in chapter I above.

UNCTAD contribution to the implementation of the Doha Programme of Action for the Least Developed Countries

2. Under the agenda item, the Board will consider the report on the activities carried out by UNCTAD between the second quarter of 2023 and the second quarter of 2024, in support of the implementation of the Doha Programme of Action for the Least Developed Countries, in a context of worsening climate impacts, slowing global economic activity, rising costs of food and energy and tightening international financing conditions. The report provides a non-exhaustive list of examples of how UNCTAD is delivering results in the least developed countries. The report is structured along the three pillars of UNCTAD work, research and policy analysis, intergovernmental consensus-building and technical cooperation, and includes lessons learned as well as policy recommendations for the way forward.
