

Report of the Credentials Committee

- 1. At its first plenary meeting, on 5 October 2015, the United Nations Conference for the Negotiation of a Successor Agreement to the International Agreement on Olive Oil and Table Olives, 2005, appointed a Credentials Committee. The membership of the Committee was as follows: Argentina, Italy, Jordan, Tunisia and Turkey.
- 2. The Credentials Committee met on 7 October 2015.
- 3. Mr. Ben Ammar (Tunisia) chaired the meeting.
- 4. The UNCTAD secretariat informed the Committee of the status of credentials of representatives as at 7 October 2015. As provided for in rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference, credentials for the Conference had been submitted to the UNCTAD secretariat by 24 States.
- 5. The Chair proposed that the Committee accept the credentials of the representatives of the member States referred in paragraph 4. There was no objection to this proposal.
- 6. The Chair then proposed that the Committee recommend to the Conference the adoption of the following draft resolution:

"Credentials of representatives to the fourth part of the United Nations Conference for the Negotiation of a Successor Agreement to the International Agreement on Olive Oil and Table Olives, 2005: The United Nations Conference for the Negotiation of a Successor Agreement to the International Agreement on Olive Oil and Table Olives, 2005, approves the report of the Credentials Committee."

7. The Committee endorsed the above proposal without a vote.
