II. ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1 - Election of officers

1. Under rule 64, paragraph 3, of the rules of procedure of the Trade and Development Board, and in accordance with the cycle of rotation for the election of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman-cum-Rapporteur, the Chairman of the Working Party at its thirty-first session shall be a representative of one of the States members in List C (Latin America and Caribbean Group). The Vice-Chairman-cum-Rapporteur shall be a representative of one of the States members in list B.

Item 2 - Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

2. The provisional agenda for the thirty-first session of the Working Party is reproduced in section I above. Substantive items 3 and 4 were decided upon by the Trade and Development Board at its sixteenth executive session on 16 February 1998. A note on the organization of work of the session will be circulated at the opening of the meeting.

Item 3 - Savings resulting from the improved overall cost-effectiveness achieved pursuant to the ninth session of the Conference

3. Pursuant to paragraphs 52-54 of General Assembly resolution 52/220 and to Board decision 447(EX-16), the report prepared by the secretariat analyses the financial impact of the reform of the secretariat and of the restructuring of the UNCTAD intergovernmental machinery. The impact is estimated in terms of "savings" by comparing the difference in the level of resources allocated to carry out the initial work programme in 1996-1997 and that provided for implementing the new work programme in the 1998-1999 biennium.
