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INDICATIVE PLAN OF UNCTAD'S TECHNICAL COOPERATION FOR 2001

Note by the UNCTAD secretariat

1. UNCTAD X, in paragraph 164(vi) of its "Plan of Action" (TD/386), requested the secretariat to submit to member States an "annual indicative plan of technical cooperation programmes".
2. Following this request, the present document includes information on:
 - (i) Ongoing projects which are expected to continue in 2001;
 - (ii) Projects proposed by the secretariat with a view to implementing the mandate of UNCTAD X, as well as mandates given to UNCTAD by the General Assembly;
 - (iii) Projects proposed as a result of specific requests received from beneficiaries.

For most projects under (ii) and (iii), financial support still needs to be identified.

3. The plan is intended to implement the Technical Cooperation Strategy of UNCTAD adopted by the Board at its fifteenth executive session in June 1997. It is also intended to:
 - (a) Inform delegations, cooperating organizations and other interested parties of the operational activities that have been approved for the year 2001 and those which the secretariat is proposing for 2001;

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(b) Facilitate discussions with potential donors on the mobilization of the necessary extrabudgetary resources to implement the plan. Barring exceptional cases, all the secretariat's requests to potential donors for funding will be from among proposals contained in this plan; and

(c) Serve as the secretariat's monitoring tool.

4. The information contained herein is broken down as follows: (a) title of the project; (b) expected duration; (c) status; and (d) when available, approximate total budget in US dollars.

5. Inclusion of new proposals (see paragraph 2(ii) and 2(iii) above) is based on one or more of the following considerations:

(i) An explicit request received by the secretariat from a developing country or a country in transition;

(ii) A request for assistance mandated by the General Assembly, by the Conference, the Trade and Development Board or a Commission;

(iii) Consistency with the implementation of the UNCTAD X Plan of Action as reflected in the work programme set out in the programme narrative for the UNCTAD programme budget for 2000-2001 (TD/B/47/3).

6. Only the projects considered a priority have been included in this version of the plan. Moreover, in response to the Bangkok Plan of Action and, in particular, its paragraph 166, projects included in the plan place particular emphasis on capacity-building. In this regard, please see paragraphs 10 to 16 below.

7. The Trade Point Programme includes requests for technical cooperation received from Governments. Bearing in mind the decision adopted by the Working Party at its thirty-fourth session in September 1999 on the follow-up to the evaluation of the Trade Point Programme (TD/B/49/9), the secretariat has decided to bring project proposals in this area to the attention of member States. Activities envisaged under these proposals are consistent with the need to help developing countries and countries in transition as per paragraphs 156 to 158 of the UNCTAD X Plan of Action, as well as paragraphs 26 and 27 of General Assembly resolution 54/198 of 22 December 1999.

8. Implementation of most of the proposals in the plan is contingent upon the mobilization of additional resources. Moreover, as it is expected that new requests will be made and that existing proposals may be modified, constant adjustments to the plan will be required.

Special focus on capacity building

9. The individual and collective ability of people in a country to sustain themselves and make progress depends critically on the quality, performance and legitimacy of their institutions and organizations on all levels of society. With this in view, the General Assembly, in its resolution 53/192 reaffirmed that “capacity building and its sustainability should be explicitly articulated as a goal of technical assistance provided by the operational activities of the UN system at the country level, with the aim of strengthening national capacities in the fields of, *inter alia*, policy and programme formulation, development management, planning, implementation, coordination, monitoring and review”. ECOSOC, in its resolution 1999/5, stressed that “the UN system should adopt flexible responses to specific capacity building needs as articulated by recipient countries in accordance with their national development plans and priorities”.

10. As defined by the ACC Guidance Note on Capacity Building, sustainable capacity building encompasses the building of organizational and technical abilities, behaviours, relationships, and values that enable individuals, groups and organizations to enhance their performance effectively to achieve their development objectives over time. It includes strengthening both the processes, systems and rules that shape collective and individual behaviour and performance in all development endeavours, as well as people’s ability and willingness to play new developmental roles and to adapt to new demands and situations.

11. Effective capacity building programmes at the country and regional level depend on:

- National ownership and commitment in the form of priority setting, skills and resources;
- Its consideration as one of the principal and explicit goals of any development programme and project, rather than a component or a by-product of such programmes/projects;
- Its pursuance on the basis of a holistic approach and a shared understanding of its definition;
- Coherence between policy analysis, technical cooperation and the intergovernmental machinery; and
- Enhanced partnership.

12. In the past few years, increased focus on capacity building has been given to technical cooperation services provided by UNCTAD. Moreover, enhancement of capacity building has been a

major concern of UNCTAD's member States. Consequently the Plan of Action of UNCTAD X gives emphasis to capacity building in all areas of UNCTAD's work.

13. In its section on technical cooperation, the Plan of Action of UNCTAD X recommended that priority should be given to those activities which enhance the capacity of beneficiary countries; the activities should have as their ultimate objectives raising the standards of living of people in developing countries through strengthening of capacity building for, *inter alia*, trade, investment and development; technical cooperation should focus on capacity building to assist developing countries integrate into the global economy (paragraph 164); and UNCTAD's existing capacity building programme should be strengthened (paragraph 166).

14. The Plan of Action also called for enhancement of technical cooperation activities, *inter alia*, through exercise of a greater degree of central oversight and the submission to member States of an annual indicative plan of technical cooperation programmes. Enhanced internal coordination will also facilitate coordination among donors for achieving coherence and complementarity of actions in support of capacity building.

15. It is against the above background that the secretariat proposals in the annual indicative plan of technical cooperation programmes for 2001 focuses on capacity building, as follows:

A. DIVISION ON GLOBALIZATION AND DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES

Projects proposed under this heading are based on the following recommendations of the Bangkok Plan of Action:

"In its technical cooperation in the field of debt, UNCTAD should undertake technical assistance on debt management, through its DMFAS Programme" (paragraph 168).

"The continuation of the assistance that the UNCTAD secretariat provides to the Palestinian people is welcome, and should be intensified" (paragraph 167).

The main capacity-building activities relate to debt management and to assistance to the Palestinian Authority.

*The debt crisis of the 1980s brought to light the importance of effective debt management, which is a central feature in government efforts to restore stability and creditor confidence. To assist in this task, UNCTAD developed a technical cooperation package known as the Debt Management and Financial Analysis System (DMFAS), designed to improve the capacity of the country to develop appropriate administrative, institutional and legal structures for effective debt management. Assistance provided under this programme consists of three main features: the installation of **software**, designed to fulfil the operational, statistical and analytical needs of debt managers; **advisory services** related to technical, administrative, legal and institutional debt management issues; and **training** in the use of the software and on debt management.*

Assistance to the Palestinian people aims to provide concrete technical assistance to examine problem areas and technical issues, advise on requisite policy measures and build the capacities of policy makers and private sector practitioners involved in developing Palestinian trade, financial and related services sectors.

B. DIVISION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN GOODS AND SERVICES, AND COMMODITIES

Projects proposed under this heading have taken into account the following recommendations of the Bangkok Plan of Action:

In the area of international trade "UNCTAD should support capacity building in developing countries so as to progressively enable these countries to become effective players in the multilateral trading system" (paragraph 129); for trade in services "analytical work should be supported by technical assistance to strengthen domestic services capacity of developing countries" (paragraph 134), and "UNCTAD should analyse ways for developing countries to improve their supply capacity in the area of trade in services through, inter alia, human resource development and institutional capacity building (paragraph 145); in the area of electronic commerce "analytical work should be complemented by capacity building activities" (paragraph 135); on the built-in-agenda and other possible areas of negotiations, "UNCTAD should support developing countries' capacity building process" (paragraph 136); with regard to its work on regional integration and the multilateral trading system "UNCTAD should help developing countries to improve their capacity to promote their trade interests in global negotiations" (paragraph 138); on competition issues "UNCTAD should strengthen the capacity of public institutions for competition and consumer protection in developing countries and help them to educate the public and representatives of the private sector (paragraph 141); in its work on trade and environment "attention is to be paid to identifying specific capacity building needs of developing countries and promoting a broad programme of capacity building on trade, environment and development" (paragraph 146). In its work on commodities UNCTAD should support developing countries "in strengthening supply capacities in export-oriented sectors of commodities" (paragraph 144)

"UNCTAD should conduct policy oriented research on the implications of the FDI, technological capacity building and enterprise internationalization for competition and competitiveness" (paragraph 121).

In the area of technology "UNCTAD should strengthen the innovative capacity of enterprises through the implementation of national policy reviews" (paragraph 124) .

More specifically, in its work on customs reform and automation, "special attention should be given to capacity building in developing countries" (paragraph 153); and "UNCTAD should contribute to informing international debates on the developmental impact of global information networks addressing, in particular, developing countries' specific problems, such as access to information technology, infrastructure constraints and build-up of human resource capacity" (paragraph 156). "Given the vital importance of national capacity building in developing countries, UNCTAD should continue its activities within its field of competence in support of human resources development" (paragraph 159).
